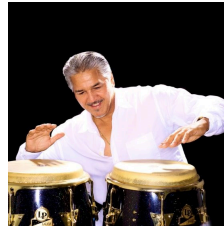

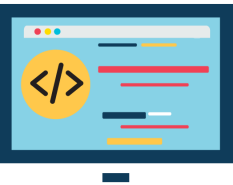
Teen Art Therapy Workshop

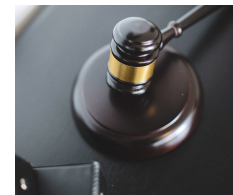
Learn to Code
