Growing up as a paralyzed girl during the 90s and early 2000s, Rebekah Taussig writes about the rhythms and textures of what it means to live in a body that doesn't fit. Rebekah reflects on everything from the complications of kindness and charity, living both independently and dependently, experiencing intimacy, and how the pervasiveness of ableism in our everyday media directly translates to daily life.
