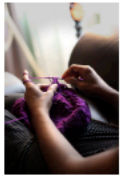
Coffee and Crochet

Wild Man Dan is back for another amazing show featuring reptiles! We will also learn about venomous creatures.

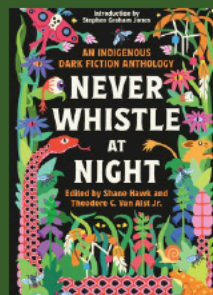
