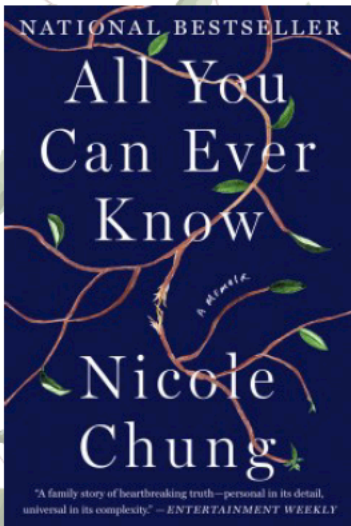


Intro to Junk Journaling

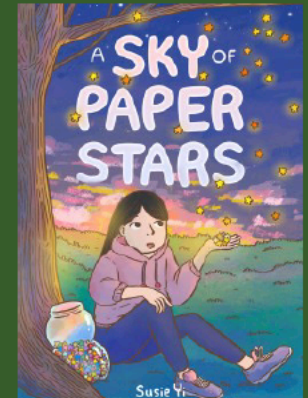
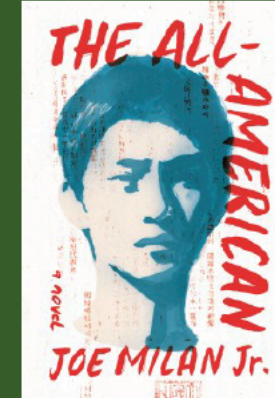
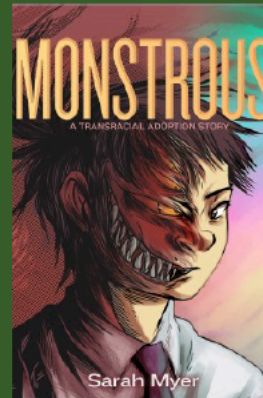
