Come in and join us for an artsy afternoon in the library, as we play a captivating Audiobook as teens hang out, unwind and color. Great opportunity to meet others and hang out!



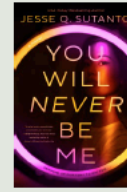
Supper & Snacks in the Stacks is back!

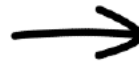
