Ages 6-11 THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 21ST | 3:30 P.M.

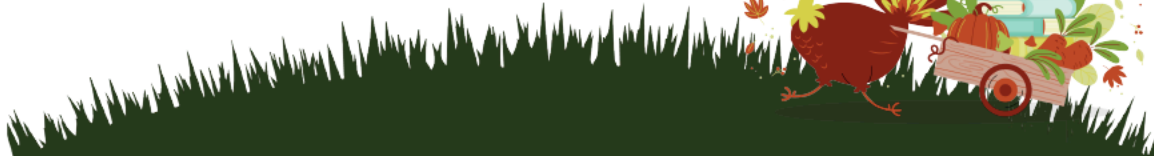
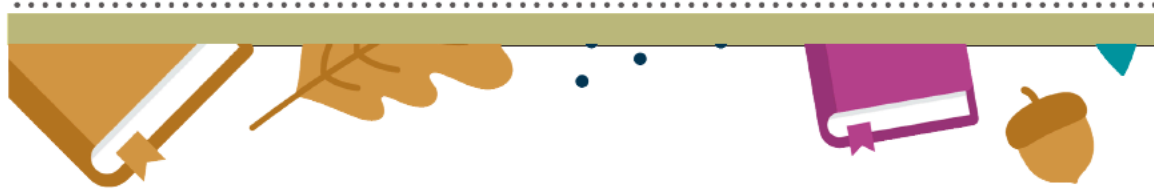
Build teamwork and creativity as you design a fort together in the library! These skills encourage problem-solving and focus, setting kids on the path to becoming strong, curious readers.
