by Chloe Liese

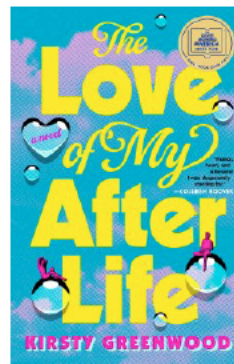

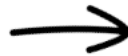
