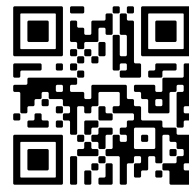
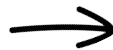

## Ages 19+ **Classic Movies**

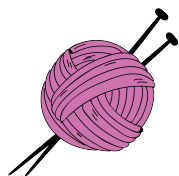
