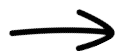

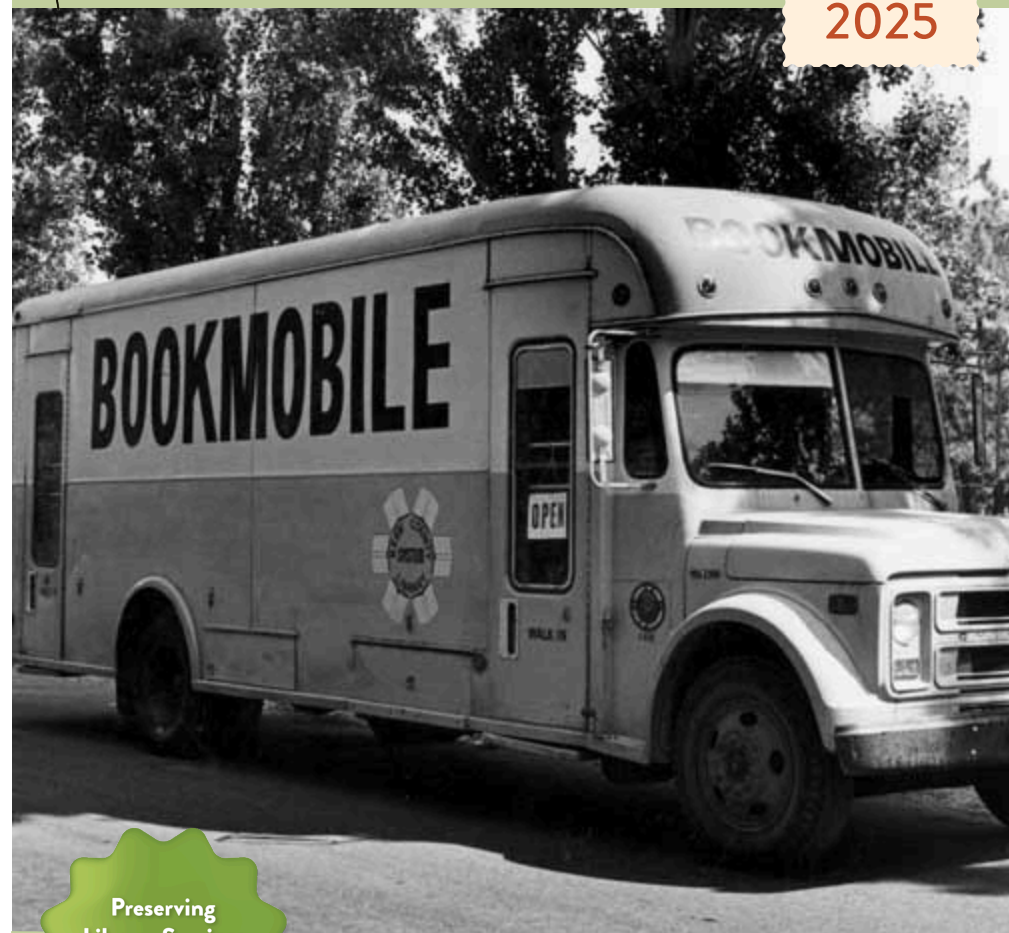

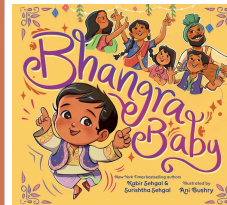


Fresh Picks for Kids

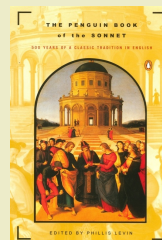

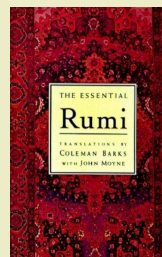
Formal & Traditional Poetry

A fantastic collection of sonnets from Shakespeare to contemporary poets, showcasing the evolution of the form.

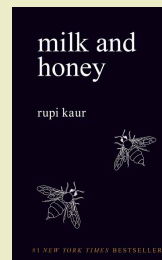
Modern & Free-Form Poetry
