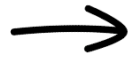

All Ages TUESDAY - SATURDAY | ALL DAY

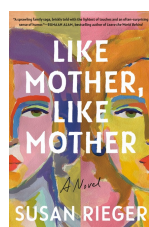
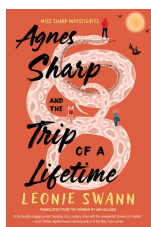
