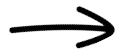

## Louie Cruz Beltran: Rhythm and Roots

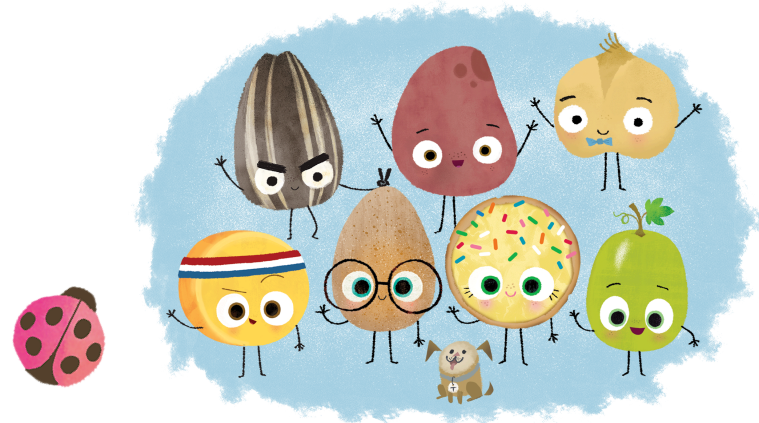
