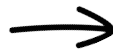

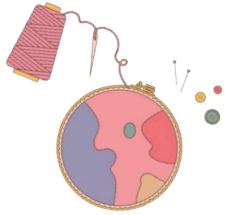

SATURDAY, JUNE 27 | 2:00 P.M.

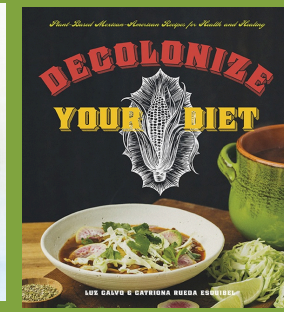
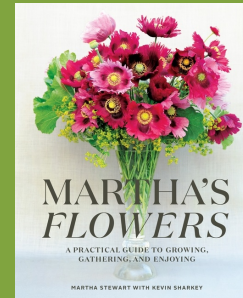
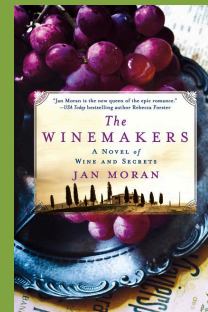
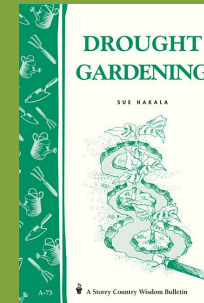
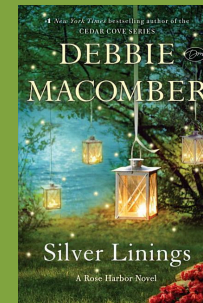
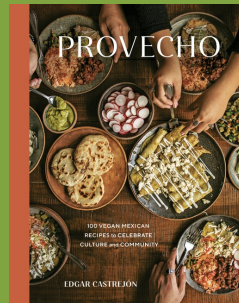
Dive into the world of stitches at our Crochet Club! Join fellow adults and hang out while making your new crochet creation(s). All materials provided—just bring your creativity!
