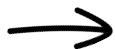

PRINT BY APPOINTMENT WITH THE 3D PRINTER

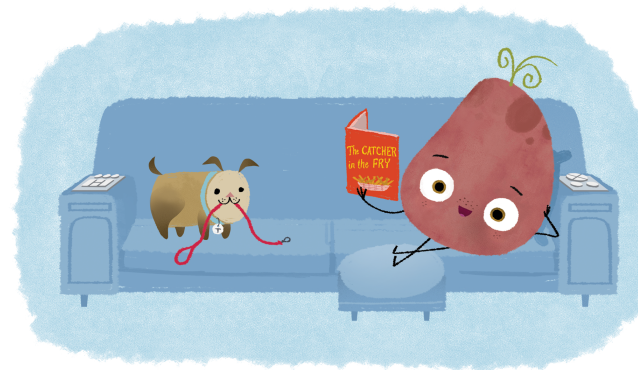
