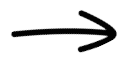

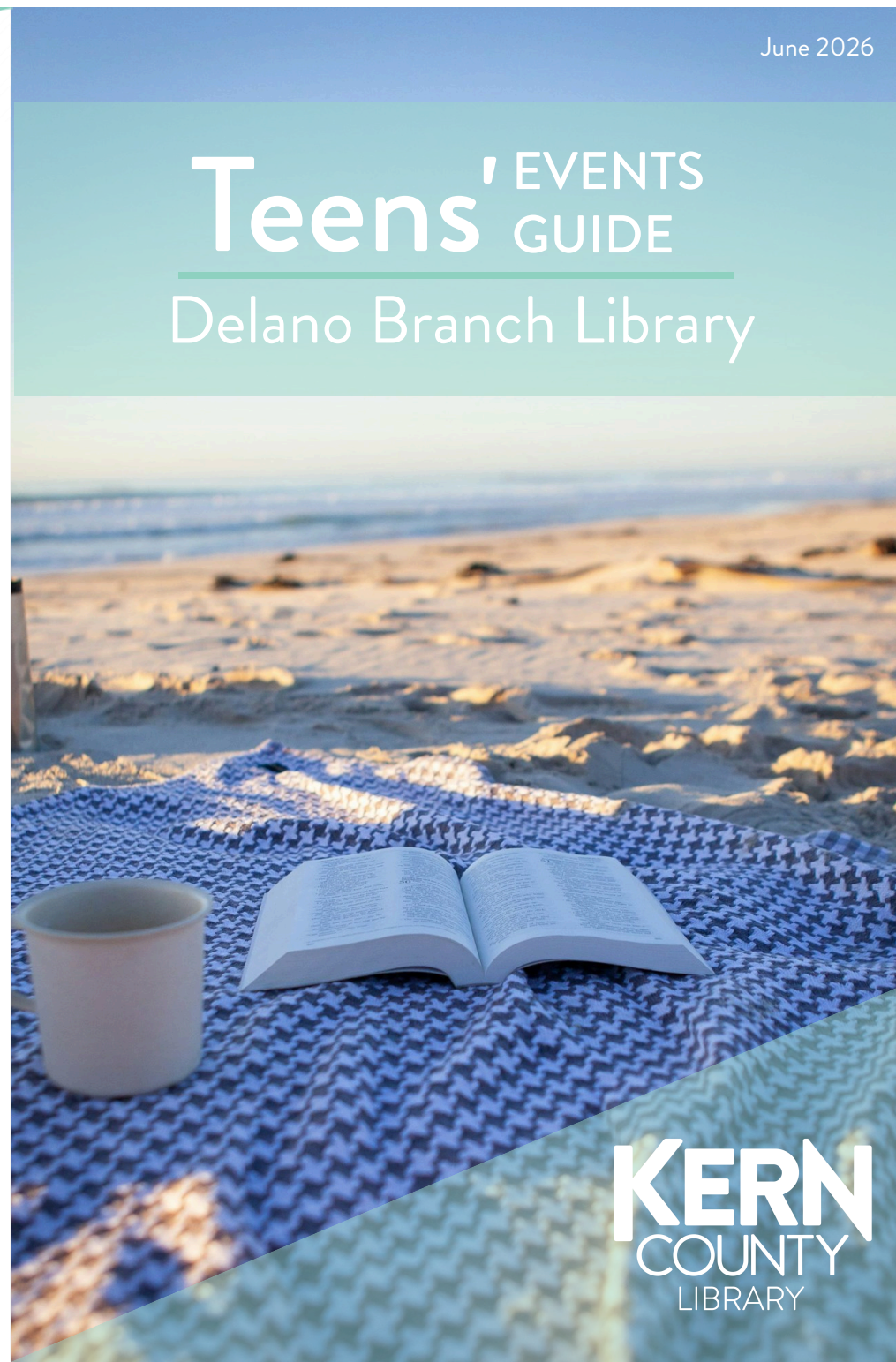

All Ages WEDNESDAY, JUNE 3 | 11:30 A.M.

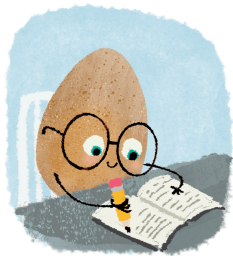
Let's kick off the summer with fun-filled games and friendly competition! Join us for a day of challenges, creativity, and laughter.
