THURSDAY, AUGUST 13TH | 3-4:30PM

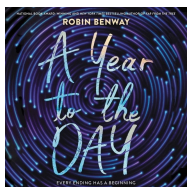
We invite you to come join us and learn the basics of how to play 'Magic the Gathering!' Or, if you already play, hang out and play with other Magic enthusiasts!
