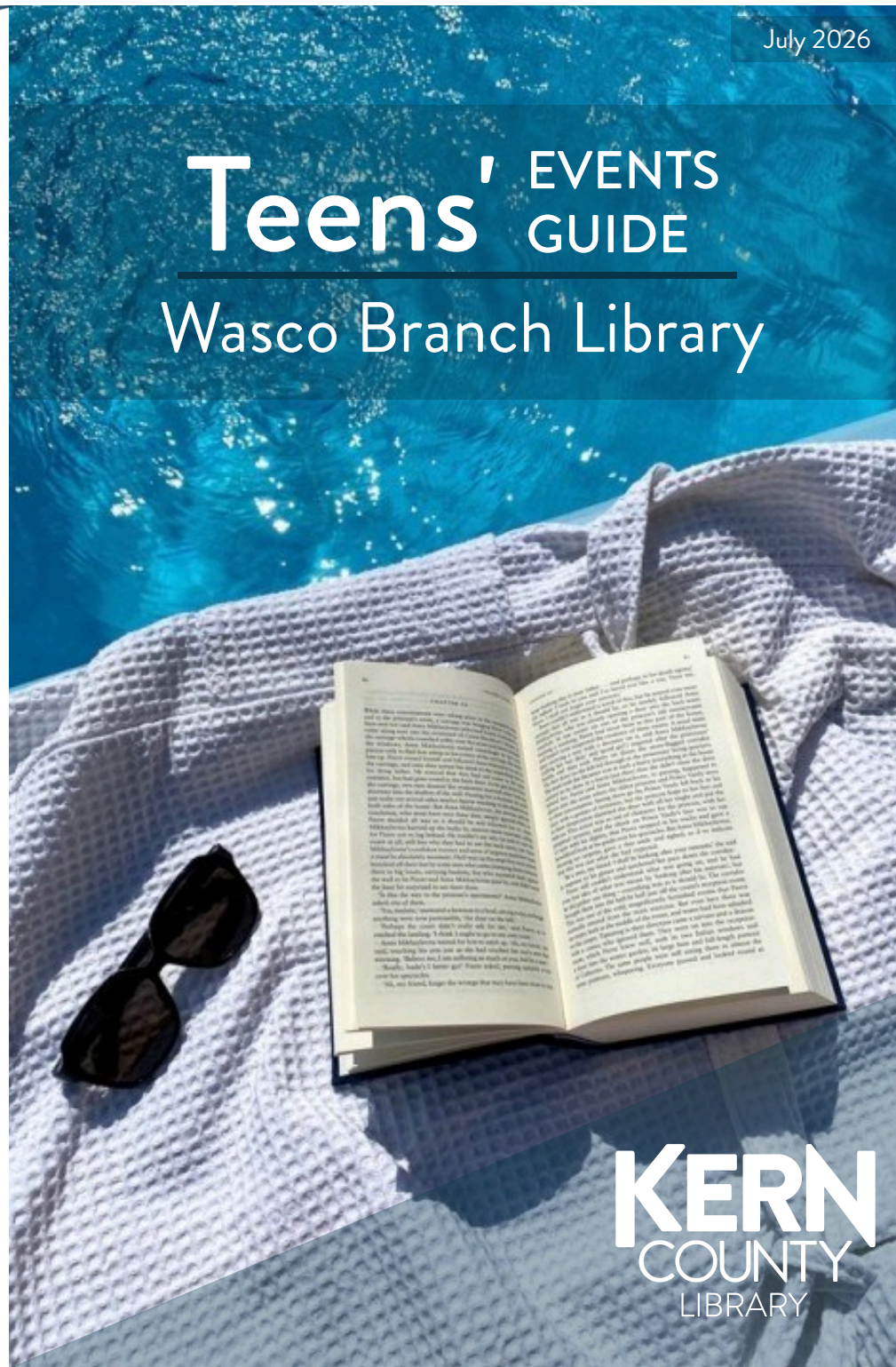

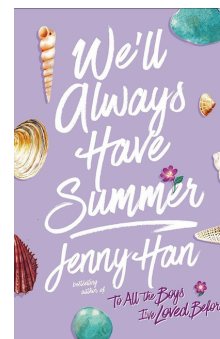
The Summer I Turned Pretty by: Jenny Han
