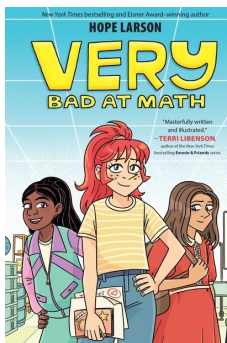
The Deal (2015) by Elle Kennedy
