Workforce Support



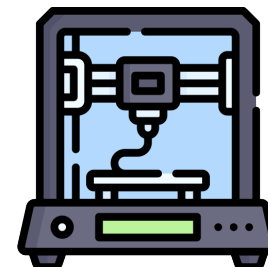
TUESDAY | SEPTEMBER 29TH | 5:00PM
